What can a Chiropodist do for me?

Chiropodists are primary healthcare providers who treat foot conditions.

Chiropodists treat people of all ages and activity levels.

Foot Care Management

- General foot care (nails, callus, corns)
- Fungal nail care
- Biomechanical assessment and orthotic management
- Shockwave and ultrasound therapy
- Compression hose therapy
- Plantar wart treatment
- Minor surgical procedures
- Cortisone injection therapy

Diabetes Related Care & Management

- Diabetes foot risk assessment and hands-on care
- Preventative Diabetes foot care
- Wound care and management
- Diabetes foot education and support
- Offloading devices
(orthotics, footwear and Total Contact Casting)
- Dry and cracked skin

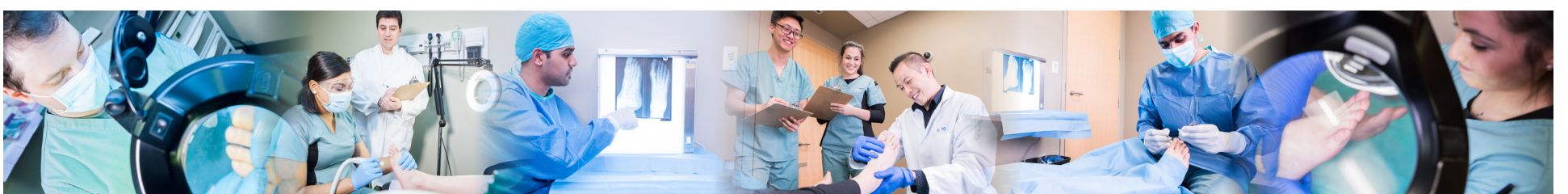
What to Expect

- This clinic is a teaching facility.
- Your care will be performed by students in The Michener Institute's Chiropody program.
- Students treat under the supervision of licensed Chiropodists who are also clinical faculty.
- There may be more than one student involved in your care during each appointment.
- Your first visit will include a full history and foot exam and a comprehensive management plan to meet your foot care needs.

Chiropody services are not covered by OHIP

Services are partially subsidized by the Chiropody Program, but a nominal fee is the responsibility of the patient upon appointment arrival. A receipt will be provided upon payment.

Third party insurance providers may provide coverage, check with your plan administrator for details.
